SCHEDULE RULES

- 1) All rules are at the discretion of the Ladies Executive and the Ice Committee and their decisions will be final. If not otherwise stated, O.C.A. rules apply.
- 2) All games will be a maximum of 8 ends.
- 3) All games must be played on time as scheduled.
- 4) The Bell Rule will be in effect for schedule curling. Once the bell rings, finish the end in play and play one more end.
- 5) Vice-skips are to record the score in the book after each game. Win
– 10 points, tie – 5 points, default – 0.
- 6) In the event of a tie in total points, the winner will be determined by game results between the teams during round robin play. If still tied, a winner will be determined by immediate throw-off after the last game. One team member will throw a rock with sweeping allowed.
- 7) Players are to arrange their own spare and notify their skip. Position-sharing curlers and/or drawn-outs must be called first. When necessary, spares may be obtained from a spare list if available or from the schedule.
- 8) Spares can play up one or two positions or can play down one position.
- 9) If less than 3 players are present, the game will be defaulted. When only 3 players are present, the front end will throw 3 rocks each, leaving 2 rocks for the skip. Under extenuating circumstances, a team is allowed to play with up to 4 spares.
- 10) A player must play in four (scheduled player) or three (position sharing player) out of seven scheduled games to be eligible for a prize and named on the trophy.
- 11) At the discretion of the Ice Committee, any player unable to continue in a schedule will be permanently replaced and, should the team win, the replacement will receive the prize and have her name on the trophy.
- 12) For schedule curling: all rinks are chosen by a free draw.
- 13) Any curler wishing to participate in competitive curling such as Ontario Curling Association (OCA) events, Major League, Mini Majors or Team Entry, must curl as a regular member or be a position-sharing or drawn-out curler in the first or second schedule. Any extraordinary exceptions to this rule will be reviewed and a decision will be made by the Executive.

NOTE: Exception to the rule for spares in schedule, playoffs, or in trophy play is: a player competing in OCA events representing Unionville, or participating in any other TCA- or OCA-related business. All requests for exceptions are to be presented in writing to the Ice Committee Chair by the player at least one week prior to the date that they are to be absent.

LADIES' SECTION

BONSPIEL RULES

(Open Bonspiels in our Club)

- 1) A straight draw, complete rink, is made each year for our own club entries – trophy winners excepted.
- 2) The personnel curling in one bonspiel is not eligible the next year, subject to player availability and Executive approval.
- 3) The standby team for the one-day and/or two-day open is an automatic entry the following year, with at least two original players.
- 4) Every member is eligible for only one Open bonspiel each year, subject to player availability and at the discretion of the Executive.
- 5) Members must enter our bonspiels through our Club with a Unionville rink unless the draw is not filled and with Executive approval.
- 6) Invitations to other curling club bonspiels **MUST NOT** be removed from the Club.
- 7) Cancellation of an entry to another Club bonspiel, after it has been accepted, is discouraged.
